SPIRITUAL WORK OF MERCY: INSTRUCT THE IGNORANT

*Learn about the Catholic faith.  
Share what you know with others. Teach by your example.*

**1 IDENTIFY A PERSON(S)** not active or outside of our Faith Community that **GOD HAS PLACED ON YOUR HEART.** Then intercede by praying five minutes daily for that person.

**THIS CAN LOOK DIFFERENT FOR EVERYONE,** FOR EXAMPLE: *ten Hail Marys, spontaneous prayer, pray a rosary, or spend time in adoration or any of these in combination throughout the month.*

**3 FIND A VIDEO TO SHARE** with the person you've discerned that you will be walking with for this month.
